Serega Foundation Sr. Sec. School offers Arts, Science and Commerce stream for Class 11 and 12 under AHSEC.

Serega Foundation College offers students a choice between Bodoland University and Gauhati University, in Arts, Science and Commerce Stream.

ADMISSION



Serega Foundation Sr. Sec. School welcome students to an enriching and joyful learning experience. The Admission Procedure is completely transparent, and has been designed to ensure a suitable fit between what the parents and children expect from the School and what the school in turn can offer to them.

Age Eligibility

Admission will be granted to candidates only if they fulfill the age criteria mentioned below:

Admission Process

Pre-Primary: Parents applying for Nursery & KG will be required to fill out an Application Form. There will be no formal tests or interviews conducted on the child. Instead, the child will be observed in a group setting to assess his/her ability to interact in a school environment.

Class 1 to 10: A simple, yet comprehensive three-stage admission process will be used:

- * Initial Screening on the basis of an Application Form
- Aptitude Test to determine the child's proficiency across different subject areas
- Interaction with child and parents to assess the child's ability and eagerness to gain from the Serega Foundation experience
- * Successful applicants will be required to carry out certain other formalities to complete the admission process .

Class 11 to 12: Students must pass out the HSLC examination conducted by SEBA, CBSE or other recognised board and have to apply for admission through Darpan Portal: <https://darpan.ahseconline.in>.

BA/BSc/BCom: Students must pass out the 12th examination conducted by AHSEC, CBSE or other recognised board can apply for Admission.

Parents/guardians can obtain the Application Form in the following ways:

- * Collect from the School Campus – No. 1 Dhansirikhuti (Bajrajhar), Rowta, Udalguri, Assam - 784508, India on payment of fees of Rs. 500/- in cash. Please retain receipt for future reference
- * Download from the School Website – www.sfeb.net.in (The fee of Rs. 5,00/- will need to be paid along with the Registration Fee at the School campus at the time of submission of the Application Form)

Rules:

1. **Study Hours:** All the students are asked to study during the mentioned hours.
Morning Time: 5:30 to 7:30 O' clock
Evening Time: 6:00 to 10:00 O' clock
(If required extra time for studies will be provided)
2. If any students want to go home they will have to take permission from the concerned authority and will have to provide consent from the parents/guardians.
3. No students are allowed to go out without the prior permission/knowledge of the authority.
If any student seeks to or is required to go out of the hostel premises for certain needs they are allowed to go during the leisure hours (Non-study hours).
4. Students are not allowed to bring in strangers/non-hostellers/friends within the premises of the hostel. If required they will have to take prior permission.
5. Students will be provided tea-break during study hours.
6. **Visiting Hours for Guardians:** Sunday:10:00am to 12:00pm.
7. **Mobile:** Mobile is not allowed to use in certain hours mentioned below.
Morning Time: 5:00 to 7:30 "o" clock
Evening Time: 6:00 to 10:00 "o" clock

RULE & REGULATIONS

For Students



A. Conduct and Discipline of students

1. It shall be the bounden duty of every student to abide by the rules and regulations of the school/college, and to conduct himself with discipline and decorum in all places and under all circumstances.
2. Every student shall attend classes regularly and punctually and shall have minimum 75% attendance.
3. Students shall be clean and decorous in dress, language and behavior.
4. Smoking, use of alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited in the college premises. Students shall not enter the school/college drunk.
5. Every student shall salute the members of the teaching staff on the occasion of first meeting them within the school/college premises and whenever he meets them in public.
6. When a teacher enters a class-room, the students shall rise and remain standing till they are directed to sit or the teacher takes his seat.
7. When classes are in session, students shall not enter or leave the class rooms without the permission of the teachers concerned.
8. Students who may be free during class-time shall not loiter on the Veranda or on the premises of the college. During such time they are to be in the Library/Reading room.
9. Every student shall handle college property with care and shall do everything in his power to preserve cleanliness and tidiness of the furniture, building and the premises. Students shall not disfigure the walls, doors, windows, furniture etc. with bills, engraving etc.
10. The loss or damage or disfigurement caused to the college articles will be made good by realising double the loss or damages so incurred from the concerned students or through a collective fine covering all the students.
11. Except in the meeting of the various College Associations, no student shall address any gathering in the college premises without the special permission of the Principal.
12. Megaphones, loudspeakers, mobile phones etc. should not be used in the campus without the express permission of the Principal. Posters, flags, memorial tombs, floral arches, festoons etc. should not be displayed in the campus.
13. Indecent behavior towards the opposite sex will not be tolerated.
14. Students shall not invite or encourage outsiders to enter the campus.
15. Demonstrations/Campaigning of any type at any time during the working days of the college is strictly prohibited within the campus.
16. Rioting/agitating against another group of students or against members of staff/principal/management on any reason what so ever is prohibited.
17. If a student or a group of students or the entire students have any grievance of any kind what so ever, it is to be brought to the attention of the Grievance cell.
18. Ragging/teasing/intimidating/harassing/using words of abuse etc. on junior students especially female students with in the campus or outside is punishable/crime under Police Act, and such matters will be immediately reported to the police.

B. Attendance & Leave of Absence

1. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Late comers shall enter class-rooms only with the permission of the teacher.
2. Students who leave class-rooms after roll call without the permission of the teacher are liable to severe punishment.

3. Impersonation at roll call will be considered as serious offence.
4. Application for leave of absence for more than 3 days due to illness should be supported by medical certificates.
5. Students absenting themselves from the college for more than 15 consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation will have their names removed from the roll and treated as temporary removal.
6. A student sent out from the class by a teacher shall lose the attendance for the duration he is out.
7. Disciplinary action including removal from the rolls will be taken against those who repeatedly absent themselves on insufficient grounds.
8. A student requiring leave for a day or a part of a day should write an application for it to the Principal or to the teacher authorised by him and get his counter signature and submit the it in the college office. Such application should be submitted on the very day of his/her return to the school/college.
